On behalf of the Charlestown Area Church Network, we invite you to join in the 2017 Harvest Walk. This annual pledge walk benefits the Fall Mountain Food Shelf, a regional food pantry which provides food and personal care items to hundreds of families and seniors in Charlestown and the surrounding area.

The Walk will take place on **Sunday, October 8, starting at 2 p.m.** The walk will begin at the **Charlestown Congregational Church, 71 Main Street, Charlestown** where walkers will register and pose for a group picture on the front steps of the parsonage. We'll supply water and apples for the walk. The route runs south on Main Street and returns via East Street, a distance of 1.8 miles. With no hills to climb, it's easy and fun for anyone at any age. We are grateful to members of the Charlestown Congregational Board of Mission for staffing the registration table.
